



## **Pisgah Health Foundation**

### **Good Neighbor Critical Need Grant**

The Pisgah Health Foundation provides for non-profits and public social service programs a way to request funds for unforeseeable critical needs that might arise as they operate for the benefit of those they serve. The program has limited assets and operates on a rolling basis. When fund assets are depleted, non-profits can still apply as the Pisgah Health Foundation will work to provide relief as processes allow. Application for the fund is not a guarantee of approval.

The following attributes constitute a critical funding need:

- An important social service will no longer be provided if funding is not received.
- The funding need is due to casualty loss, equipment failure or abrupt termination of a reliable resource.
- An unforeseeable emergency occurs in the community requiring immediate increased capacity for the services the organization provides.

The program requires submittal of a 1 page “fast response” letter of need.” The program will be given a rapid response review and qualified applicants will be invited to apply for assistance. The Pisgah Health Foundation strives for a two-week turnaround on requests from the time the application process is complete.
